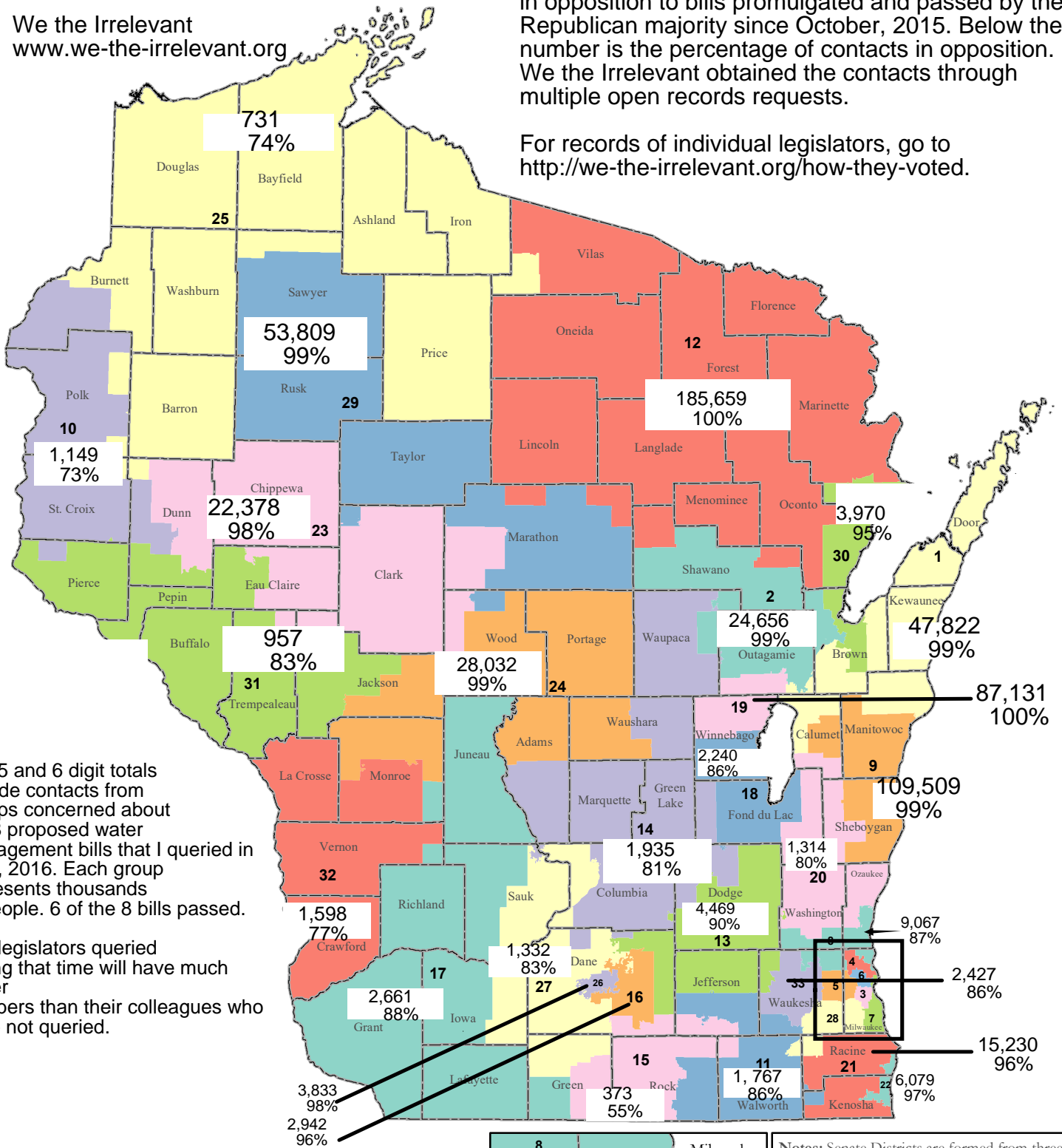

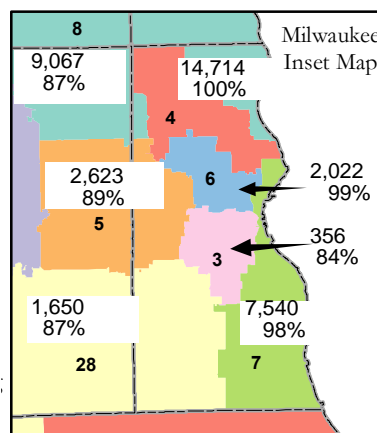
The numbers on this map represent citizen contacts in opposition to bills promulgated and passed by the Republican majority since October, 2015. Below the number is the percentage of contacts in opposition. We the Irrelevant obtained the contacts through multiple open records requests.

The 5 and 6 digit totals include contacts from groups concerned about the 8 proposed water management bills that I queried in April, 2016. Each group represents thousands of people. 6 of the 8 bills passed.

The legislators queried during that time will have much larger numbers than their colleagues who were not queried.



Notes: Senate Districts are formed from three consecutive Assembly Districts. For example, Senate District 1 is comprised of Assembly Districts 1, 2, 3.
